

CREDENTIALS AND TRAINING:

Michelle L. Dean, MA, ATR-BC, LPC, CGP is a Registered, Board Certified Art Psychotherapist, Licensed Professional Counselor (PA) and Certified Group Psychotherapist. Ms. Dean earned her Master's degree in *Creative Arts Therapies – Art Therapy* from Hahnemann University (now Drexel University) in 1996. Ms. Dean is a nationally recognized expert in treating individuals who have eating disorders, complex trauma, and relationship issues. Her work history includes nearly twenty years with eating disordered programs and private practice. Prior to her co-founding, The Center for Psyche & the Arts, LLC, her institutional work included many years working at The Renfrew Center as the Trauma Track Coordinator and Art Therapy Coordinator where she worked with inpatients as well as IOP individuals, The Belmont Center for Comprehensive Treatment on Units for patients with Eating Disorders, Addictions, the Children's Unit, and with the clients of the Adult Day Program. Ms. Dean was frequently called upon to perform art therapy assessments hospital wide. She was the Activities Therapies Supervisor at Hunting Hospital where she oversaw the recreation and creative arts therapists while working on the inpatient psychiatric and geriatric units. Additionally, she was a primary therapist at Women Against Rape and Crime Victims Services, where she facilitated individual and family therapy with children as young as 2 who were victims of violent crimes. Ms. Dean is passionate about educating and mentoring students and professionals. She began supervising graduate students the same year she became an Adjunct Professor at Arcadia University, where she instructed undergraduate art therapy courses since 1997. She has been as a supervisor for many graduate students, ATR and LPC candidates, as well as clinicians wanting to further their knowledge about art therapy, the therapeutic uses of art, eating disorders, and other related topics. Ms. Dean is the author of the children's book, *Taking weight problems to school* (JayJo Press, 2005) and the chapter, "Preserving the self: Treating eating disordered individuals who self-injure with art therapy" in *Creative arts therapies with patients who*

have eating disorders, edited by S. Brooke (Charles C. Thomas, 2008) and two recent chapter publications: “Cultural Considerations of Eating Disorders Through Art Therapy” in P. Howie, S. Prasad and J. Kristel (Eds), *Using Art Therapies with Diverse Populations: Crossing Cultures and Abilities*, (Jessica Kingsley Publishers) and “Printmaking: Reflective and Receptive Impressions in the Therapeutic Process” in M. Rosel and D. Gussak (Eds). *Wiley-Blackwell Handbook of Art Therapy*, currently in press. Her work has earned two Faculty Development Grants from Arcadia University as well as been awarded the Delaware Valley Art Therapy Association’s Innovations in Art Therapy Award (2007), The Ronald E. Hays Presenter’s Award (2009), and the Honorary Life Member Award (2012).

PROFESSIONAL CODE AFFIRMATION STATEMENT: As an Art Therapist and Licensed Professional Counselor, I affirm to maintain high standards of professional competence and integrity as outlined in the ATCB Code of Professional Practice (<http://www.atcb.org/home/code>) and the PA State Board of Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors (ST-SOCIALWORK@pa.gov) respectively. These standards are intended to protect the welfare of the clients and community I serve.

PHILOSOPHICAL / THEORETICAL APPROACH TO SUPERVISION:

Ms. Dean brings her extensive training in art, psychotherapy, and the creative process to her work as a clinician. As a board certified, registered art therapist, licensed professional counselor, and certified group psychotherapist she is able to utilize nonverbal expression and exploration through a variety of art materials in addition to verbal processing. Her person-centered, holistic approach uses art and creativity to facilitate symbolic communication, insight, growth and healing. Ms. Dean's approach is multi-modal, strength-based, and focused on the needs of each individual she works with. Goals are set collaboratively with the client and the method for reaching them is unique to each individual or group.

In order for Michelle L. Dean, MA, ATR-BC, LPC to provide the best possible services to me, I understand that she may need to consult with other persons, professionals and non-professionals, and agencies, and I hereby authorize her to discuss my case with such other persons and agencies as she, in her sole opinion, deems appropriate. In the event of a referral to another supervisor or facility or the need arises for Michelle Dean, MA, ATR-BC, LPC to contact other persons or agencies not described in the previous sentence, such a referral or contact will not occur without my prior written consent.

FEES FOR SUPERVISION: \$150 per 60-minute hour. Group Therapy is \$50 per hour and are subject to change. Sliding scales may be available on an individual basis and based on need. Payment method: cash, check or credit card through online services such as PayPal™ and Square™. Payment is due at time of service. Payments are to be made payable to The Center for Psyche & the Arts, LLC. Cancellations must be made at least 24 hours in advance, or clients will be billed for the session in full. Supervisee is responsible for the full fee for missed group sessions and that the above cancellation policy does not apply to groups. Full fees will be charged for missed group sessions.

In addition to office visits and group sessions, other services by Ms. Dean for which supervisee will be billed include, but are not limited to: face-to-face time in the office; record review time; report preparation; communication (e-mail, fax, phone, mail) with me or other people at my request. Fees for services other than office visits are due within 30 days from the date of invoice.

Supervisee will be provided a receipt for payment within seven days of requesting it.

If any of my checks issued for payment for services performed by Ms. Dean of The Center for Psyche & the Arts, LLC are returned or not honored by her financial institution, for any reason supervisee will be charged a \$50 returned check fee, or the

fee for returned checks charged by The Center for Psyche & the Arts, LLC's financial institution plus a \$20 administration fee, whichever is higher. Balances remaining outstanding after thirty (30) days will bear interest at the rate of twelve (12%) percent per annum.

GRIEVANCES: It is recommended that every attempt to resolve a grievance is made with Ms. Dean is done so quickly and directly. This way the supervisee may determine if the work together can be more efficient and effective or whether a referral would be appropriate.
